# How to Set Up Your Cupid's Cup Fundraising Page

We are using a crowdfunding format on our MobileCause platform. It is very easy to set it up.

1. Go to the link: <https://app.mobilecause.com/join/star/Cupid>
2. Put in your name and email and click on the Become a Fundraiser button.
3. Click on Join a Team. ***Don't customize your page yet, you will do this later (so ignore that button for now).***
4. Select the team that you want to join. (You might need to scroll down to see all four teams). Teams are Gordy & Brittany, Mater & Shawn, Dagur & Brittney (STAR Intern), and Bug & Sanya.
5. Customize your page. Here you can add your own story and your own picture.
6. Hit Save.
7. All done! Now just share you page!

\*\*You should get an email from Crowdfunding from MobileCause (check your clutter or junk folder if you don't see it in your inbox) that has a link to your page.
